IN-CLASS BACHELOR PROGRAM STUDENT AGREEMENT

Dear Student,

Your Instructor made the first two years of Ministry International Institute a priority and has voiced a great desire for the Bachelor Program; therefore, MII has chosen to bless you. The cost of MII's two year Bachelor Program (60 credit hours) is \$6,000.00; however, we have chosen to scholarship \$4,375.00 of this fee. **Your cost for this course is \$1,625.00.**

A book order fee of \$250.00 per student for the first year of the course is due three weeks before the beginning date of the class. After the initial payment of \$250.00 students will be required to make 15 monthly payments of \$75.00 beginning the first month of class. When the student enters the second year of the course they will be required to pay an additional book order fee of \$250.00. In order to take these courses for credit you must complete, sign and submit the Application and Addendum Forms for acceptance into the Bachelor Program and have an original transcript on file with MII.

Please Note: This is an agreement that all tuition and fees must be paid, and all course work completed before a student can graduate. In order for you to have books on the first day of school, the first \$250.00 must be paid 3 weeks before the first class to MII at the address listed above.
